The Alaska District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has initiated a study to coordinate, plan and provide an overall assessment on prioritization of shoreline erosion management efforts in the state of Alaska. The Corps, working with the State and other stakeholders, will develop this baseline study to provide a reasonable and measured response to erosion issues in Alaska, and will provide those affected by erosion recommendations on ways they can address their concerns.

The FY2005 Consolidated Appropriations, Conference Report contained the following language:

"The conference finds there is a need for an Alaska erosion baseline study to coordinate and plan the appropriate responses and assistance for Alaska villages in the most need and to provide an overall assessment on the priority of which villages should receive assistance. Therefore, the conference has provided the \$2,000,000 for this study."

The Alaska District is pleased to invite you to participate on the Technical Committee for this study. The Technical Committee will assist in coordination of the various actions with the working level representatives of key study stakeholders. This committee will make recommendations for what studies and efforts should be undertaken, will develop the list of communities to be established, and develop the criteria for the prioritization list.

The Alaska District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has initiated a study to coordinate, and plan shoreline erosion management efforts in the State of Alaska. The baseline study will be used to determine the scale and urgency of the erosion problem and to provide those affected by erosion recommendations for how they can address their concerns. We are working with other agencies to identify erosion hazardous areas that will be studied later in more detail. After we identify such areas we will solicit input from stakeholders, including tribes, related on the selected areas.

Please consider this letter our notification of proposed Department of Defense activity under the Department of Defense American Indian and Alaska Native Policy. The proposed activity will consist of the baseline erosion study mentioned in the preceding paragraph. Once an area has been identified for a more detailed study, the tribes from that area will be invited to enter into government-to-government consultation on tribal rights and/or protected resources that may be affected by this activity.

The Corps, pursuant to the Department of Defense American Indian and Alaska Native Policy (DoD Policy), notified the Native Village of Napaskiak by letter December 5, 2005 of the start-up of the Alaska Baseline Erosion Study. The Corps also provided an opportunity to consult on tribal rights and/or protected resources affected by the Baseline Erosion Study by letter dated March 24, 2006.

The Alaska District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has initiated a study to coordinate, and plan shoreline erosion management efforts in the State of Alaska. The baseline study will be used to determine the scale and urgency of the erosion problem and to provide recommendations to those affected by erosion as to how they can effectively address their concerns. As a part of this assessment we will be visiting Napaskiak the week of 10 September 2007, Ms. Chelan Schreifels will be contacting you by phone when the flight reservations are booked to confirm the exact dates that the assessment team will be in your community. During this visit we will be establishing the baseline for the erosion affecting the community and speaking with community leaders and residents to determine their concerns regarding erosion.

The project has been restarted and the team will again be working with Federal, State, Regional, and Alaska Native stakeholders as well as federally recognized tribes to coordinate and plan appropriate assessments to erosion issues in many of Alaska's communities. Through collaborative efforts two years ago, approximately 169 communities were identified as having some sort of erosion issue that should be assessed. With current funds provided by Congress, the Corps will be performing erosion assessment for each of the identified communities.

As part of the assessment process, a contractor working for the Corps of Engineers will be contacting an appropriate member of the community or tribe to ask a series of question pertaining to your erosion problem.
