### **Erosion Information Paper - Wasilla, Alaska**

Current as of September 4, 2007

#### **Community Information**

Wasilla (WAH-sill-ah), population of 6,775, is approximately 43 miles north of Anchorage midway between the Matanuska and Susitna Valleys, along the George Parks Highway. It is a first class city within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

#### **Description of Erosion Problem**

Lucille Creek and Cottonwood Creek flood periodically, but there are no reports of erosion problems.

#### **Potential Damages**

No erosion damages were reported by the City of Wasilla.

#### **Photos and Diagram**

No photos were provided by the community as there were no reports of erosion problem areas during the Community Erosion Survey. A diagram was not prepared.
