




**AUTHORIZATION:** Water Resources Development Act 2000, Section 101(b)(1) of the Water Resources and Development Act of 2000, PL 106-60, 11 Dec 2000. SEC. 101. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS: (b) PROJECTS SUBJECT TO FINAL REPORT- The following projects for water resources development and conservation and other purposes are authorized to be carried out by the Secretary substantially in accordance with the plans, and subject to the conditions, recommended in a final report of the Chief of Engineers if a favorable report of the Chief is completed not later than December 31, 2000: (1) FALSE PASS HARBOR, ALASKA- The project for navigation, False Pass Harbor, Alaska, at a total cost of \$15,552,000, with an estimated Federal cost of \$9,374,000 and an estimated non-Federal cost of \$6,178,000.

**PROJECT USEAGE:** The new small boat harbor will be used as a base for commercial fishing which is the primary industry of False Pass, Alaska.

**PROGRESS OF WORK:**

2009 - About 98,000 cubic yards of material was dredged and placed upland and adjacent to the harbor. The new harbor has three breakwaters and a causeway with a bridge and dock. The north breakwater is about 264' long. The east breakwater is 948' long and the causeway is 761' long. The south breakwaters are about 32' and 182' long. The federal cost was \$2,071,600.
