B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: Vegetation on the property consists of paper birch and quaking aspen, both facultative upland species. Wetlands are not mapped within the property according to USFWS National Wetland Mapper and the soils on the property, Fairbanks silt loam, 3 to 7 percent slopes and 7 to 12 percent slopes, are well-drained and considered non-hydric. No parameters were met in determining if wetlands are present.
