B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND:

A majority of the tree and sapling stratum vegetation on site appears to consist of upland species such as Populus balsamifera and Betula papyrifera. No saturation or other signs of hydrology are visible on aerial imagery or ground photographs provided by the applicant, and the existing bulkhead prevents the site from any physical connection to the Yukon River. The Alaska Exploratory Survey and Land Resource Regions handbook indicates that soils in the area are excessively drained with shallow to moderately deep layers of permafrost, and sandy,
