The following condition applies to this permit modification: 1. Replacement of wetland function and aquatic features are required at a minimum 110% of the function for all wetlands prior to development of the Fort Knox Mine, as required by special condition 11 of POA-1992-574-T, dated January 25, 2008.

1-Nov-11	POA-1974-312-M3_George Inlet	Permit Modification	Patricia Shaughnessy	Construct a 12-inch thick by 96-foot long concrete wall breakwater, laterally supported by 14 galvanized steel trusses. All work would occur during low tides to avoid in-water work. There would be no excavation; galvanized steel rods would be driven into the bottom where there is no bedrock, then the concrete wall and bracing foundations would be poured in place. No fill is proposed for this project and the existing creosote pilings would be removed
8-Nov-11	POA-2004-10_Clover Passage	Letter of Permission	Van Abbott	Construct a 30-foot by 4-foot floating dock and 52-foot by 3-foot ramp below the mean high water mark of Clover Passage, to dock a private recreational boat.
14-Nov-11	POA-2010-656-M1_Zimovia Strait	Permit Modification	City and Borough of Wrangell / Al-Haddad Amber	Discharge of dredged and fill material into 6.96 acres of jurisdictional wetlands and 123 lineal feet of perennial stream to facilitate the construction of a community hospital and future medical support facilities.

21-Nov-11	POA-2010-700_Tongass Narrows	Permit	Mr. Dave Doyon	Removal and replacement of an existing 140-foot by 84-foot wood dock supported by creosote pilings, by: discharging 5,240 cubic yards (cy) of clean shot rock, 730 cy of armor rock, and 625 cy of dredged material below the high tide line of Tongass Narrows to create a 0.23-acre fill pad; placement of a 40-foot by 12-foot wood float and a 12-foot by 16-foot wood pier, supported by two 18-inch galvanized steel pilings; and dredging 625 cy of material to the -10 elevation within a 90-foot by 25-foot area to allow for vessel clearance at the proposed new float location. The purpose of the work is to upgrade existing vessel mooring and service facilities at Doyons Landing.
21-Nov-11	POA-2011-65_Koyukuk River	Permit	Huslia Tribal Council / Al Yatlin Jr.	Construct 1,800 linear feet of new road across wetlands. The project will place 5,000 cubic yards of sand and crushed rock in 1.2 acres of wetlands. The road will have a 20-foot-wide driving surface and 2:1 side slopes. No work will occur below ordinary high water (OHW) of the Koyukuk River. The crushed rock will be mined from an existing upland site approximately 9 miles away that is accessible only during winter using heavy equipment. The project also includes improvements to 0.9 mile of existing roadway located on uplands, which are not subject to DA jurisdiction.
21-Nov-11	POA-2011-890, Kwiguk Pass	Permit	Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities	Place 26,000 cubic yards of fill material into 7.8 acres of wetland to construct new residential streets in Emmonak. TypicCII roadway driving surface would be up to 10 feet wide with 3: 1 side slopes. Additional barge landing work would impact 0.1 acre.
