ANNOUNCING THE ALASKA DISTRICT'S REGIONAL CONDITIONS TO THE NEW NATIONWIDE PERMITS

On January 13, 2021, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) published a final rule in the *Federal Register* (86 FR 2744) announcing the reissuance of 12 existing nationwide permits (NWPs) and four new NWPs, as well as the reissuance of NWP general conditions and definitions with some modifications. These 16 NWPs will go into effect on March 15, 2021, and will expire on March 14, 2026:

- NWP 12 Oil or Natural Gas Pipeline Activities
- NWP 21 Surface Coal Mining Activities
- NWP 29 Residential Developments
- NWP 39 Commercial and Institutional Developments
- NWP 40 Agricultural Activities
- NWP 42 Recreational Facilities
- NWP 43 Stormwater Management Facilities
- NWP 44 Mining Activities
- NWP 48 Commercial Shellfish Mariculture Activities
- NWP 50 Underground Coal Mining Activities
- NWP 51 Land-Based Renewable Energy Generation Facilities
- NWP 52 Water-Based Renewable Energy Generation Pilot Projects
- NWP 55 Seaweed Mariculture Activities
- NWP 56 Finfish Mariculture Activities
- NWP 57 Electric Utility Line and Telecommunications Activities
- NWP 58 Utility Line Activities for Water and Other Substances

The 12 reissued NWPs published in the January 13, 2021, final rule replaces the 2017 versions of these NWPs. The 2017 versions of NWPs 12, 21, 29, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 48, 50, 51, and 52 expire on March 14, 2021.

This SPN announces the approval of 10 regional conditions by the Pacific Ocean Division Commander. Subsequent to the January 13, 2021, *Federal Register* notice, the Alaska District finalized the regional conditions for the new and reissued NWPs. The regional conditions ensure that the NWPs authorize only those activities that individually and cumulatively result in no more than minimal adverse environmental effects in Alaska.

The Alaska District prepared supplemental decision documents to the Corps' final decision documents for the new and reissued NWPs. These supplemental decision documents address regional conditioning of the NWPs. Final decision documents for the new and reissued NWPs can be found at www.regulations.gov, at docket number COE-2020-0002. Alaska District supplemental decision documents are available upon request.

Additionally, the Alaska District received water quality certifications (WQC) issued by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for the issuance of these NWPs. Conditions on the water quality certifications become conditions of these NWPs. Although the WQCs address more than the above identified NWPs, they will only apply to the above 16 NWPs at this time.

Attached are: an index of the final NWP general conditions and definitions; the Alaska District's regional conditions; and the complete WQC decisions for Alaska issued by ADEC and EPA. There are 40 existing NWPs that were not reissued or modified by the January 13, 2021, final rule. Those 40 NWPs were published in the January 6, 2017, issue of the Federal Register (82 FR 1860), and those NWPs remain in effect until the Corps issues a final rule reissuing those NWPs or March 18, 2022, whichever comes first. The 40 2017 NWPs that remain in effect are:

The water quality certifications, as well as regional conditions and general conditions for these 40 NWPs that were approved by division engineers in 2017, remain in effect while these 2017 NWPs remain in effect.
