SPECIAL PUBLIC NOTICE Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) Donlin Gold Project

SUMMARY: The Corps is the lead federal agency for this EIS. The Bureau of Land Management; U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration; U.S. Environmental Protection Agency; the Alaska Department of Natural Resources; the Aniak/Kuskokwim River Watershed Council; and the federally recognized Tribal governments of Crooked Creek, Chuathbaluk, Knik and Napaimute serve as cooperating agencies in developing the EIS. The Corps is announcing the availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, as amended, the Corps' regulations for NEPA implementation (33 Code of Federal Regulation [CFR] par 230 and 325, Appendices B and C), and in accordance with 40 CFR 1506.9. A notice of availability will be published in the Federal Register on November 25, 2015 announcing a five+ months public comment period ending on April 30, 2016.

PROJECT: The Corps prepared this Draft EIS to analyze the impacts of issuing permits for an open pit, hardrock gold mine 10 miles north of the village of Crooked Creek on the Kuskokwim River in southwest Alaska. In addition to the proposed mine, the project would:

Construct a 315 mile natural gas pipeline from Cook Inlet through the Alaska Range to the mine site;

• Construct a new port at Angyaruaq (Jungjuk) on the Kuskokwim River and a 30-mile access road to the proposed mine site;

- · Require expansion of the Bethel Yard Dock and fuel terminals in Dutch Harbor; and
- · Supply equipment, cargo and diesel fuel using barges operated on the Kuskokwim River.
