On August 27, 2004, the Alaska District Corps of Engineers published Public Notice Number POA-2001-1080, Seldovia Slough, for an application received for a Department of the Army permit. The application was from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to rehabilitate and update existing facilities at the Seldovia Airport in Seldovia, Alaska. The work would include reconstructing and widening the access road and extending the north runway safety area.

The Public Notice, under Essential Fish Habitat, states that the applicant proposes to construct side slopes at 2.5:1 to minimize the project footprint in order to mitigate impacts to EFH. This information is partially incorrect. The side slopes for the access road would be 2.5:1 but the slopes for the runway safety area extension would be as shown on Sheet 8 of the project plan that was included in the Public Notice.
