On November 26, 2018, the Alaska District Corps of Engineers (Corps) published a Public Notice (PN) for Department of the Army (DA) permit number POA-1922-00022-M26, Tongass Narrows for a DA permit application from the City of Ketchikan, to remove up to 15 vertical feet of rock (7,500 cubic yards) from a 0.76-acre of Tongass Narrows, bringing the ocean bottom depth to -42 feet Mean Lower Low Water. The project site is located within Section 30, T. 75 S., R. 91 E., Copper River Meridian; Latitude 55.3392° N., Longitude 131.6494° W.; in Ketchikan, Alaska.

The PN did not include a Notice of Application for State Water Quality Certification. This revised PN includes such notification. STATE WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION**

Any applicant for a federal license or permit to conduct an activity that might result in a discharge into navigable waters, in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act of 1977 (PL95-217), also must apply for and obtain certification from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation that the discharge will comply with the Clean Water Act, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws. By agreement between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Department of Environmental Conservation, application for a Department of the Army permit to discharge dredged or fill material into navigable waters under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act also may serve as application for State Water Quality Certification.

Notice is hereby given that the application for a Department of the Army Permit described in the Corps of Engineers' Public Notice (PN) Reference Number **POA-1922-00022-M26, Tongass Narrows**, serves as application for State Water Quality Certification from the Department of Environmental Conservation.

After reviewing the application, the Department may certify there is reasonable assurance the activity, and any discharge that might result, will comply with the Clean Water Act, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws. The Department also may deny or waive certification.
