## **REISSUANCE OF REGIONAL GENERAL PERMIT (RGP) POA-2007-00541-M2 (RGP-07) DISCHARGE OF FILL MATERIAL IN WETLANDS FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT**

The Alaska District, United States (U.S.) Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), in accordance with regulations pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344), has reissued Regional General Permit (RGP-07) POA-2007-00541-M2 pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act 78631968. This RGP expires on September 30, 2024.

RGP changes after the Public Notice:

- The RGP excluded area was amended to include Annette Island and Denali National Park
- General Conditions and Special Conditions Sections were merged, and duplicate conditions were removed.
- General Condition #31(c) was updated to authorize a 60-foot wide footprint for roads.
- General Condition was added to require a Self-Certification form to be completed and submitted to the Corps within 60 days of completion of the project.
