
Project Authorization

- Rivers and Harbors Act, 2 March 1945
- House Document No. 579, 76th Congress, 3rd Session
 - "...provide a channel 10 feet deep and 60 feet wide through the outer entrance, and a channel 8 feet deep and 40 feet wide through the inner entrance..."
 - "Maintenance will not be required."
- Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act, 16 December 2016 (Public Law 114-322)
 - Sec. 1109. Maintenance of Harbors of Refuge
 - "The Secretary is authorized to maintain federally authorized harbors of refuge to restore and maintain the authorized dimensions of the harbors."








Federal Dredge Extents Outer Channel



Federal Dredge Extents Inner Channel








Closing lines between ocean and inland waters.




Several inland sites identified for further evaluation. Approximately 3 nautical miles from Elfin Cove.





Proposed Placement Site(s)




Two ocean sites identified for further evaluation. Approximately 0.6 nautical miles from Elfin Cove.
