- Today radars, radios, AIS, e-mail, web, and satellites.






Cook Inlet Traffic





Area To Be Avoided (ATBA) Monitoring Olympic Coast Marine Sanctuary




Long Term Voluntary Compliance with ATBA





Bering Strait Transits by Section – 2009




Bering Strait Transits by Section – 2010




Bering Strait Region Vessel Tracks, Q3 2010




Barrow Passage Line

Arctic Shipping Routes: AIS vessel traffic near Barrow, 2010








City of Juneau Proposed Dock Expansion Alternatives Navigation Study






Port of Juneau Vessel Activity




Port of Juneau Historical Vessel Tracks




Port Development Check List
