The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), on behalf of the United States Coast Guard, has prepared an environmental assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the following project:

Jewel Beach Stormwater Outfall Replacement U.S. Coast Guard Station Kodiak, Alaska

Decades of ground subsidence and exposure to wave and storm action have greatly reduced the Jewel Beach outfall's capacity to function properly under normal storm conditions.

The proposed project and potential environmental impacts are described in the enclosed EA and unsigned FONSI, which is available for public review and comment for 15 days from the date of this notice.
