The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Alaska District, is preparing a Draft Integrated Feasibility Report and Environmental Assessment for the following project:

Kotzebue Harbor Feasibility Study Navigation Improvements at Cape Blossom, Kotzebue, Alaska

The proposed project and initial analysis of potential environmental impacts are described in the draft report, which is being submitted to elicit public review and comment on the Recommended Plan of a dredged channel from approximately minus 26 feet (ft) Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW) extending 4,700 ft to a dock located at minus 12 ft MLLW. Included in the Recommended Plan is a trestle that extends from the uplands to the dock at Cape Blossom (12 miles south of Kotzebue).
