The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Alaska District has prepared a draft Integrated Feasibility Report and Environmental Assessment (IFREA) for the following project:

Robe Lake Ecosystem Restoration
Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) Section 206
Valdez, Alaska

The USACE Alaska District proposed project is authorized under the CAP Section 206 of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 1996 (33 U.S.C. §2330), as amended. Under the authority provided by Section 206 of the WRDA of 1996, USACE may plan, design and build projects to restore aquatic ecosystems for fish and wildlife.
